מנחה: We begin with the WEEKDAY Mincha	20	3	9
Candle lighting at 6:34 PM			
קבלת שבת: Because it is also Erev Shabbat, we recite 2 Psalms from Kabbalat Shabbat before beginning Ma'ariv	46-48	21	49
מעריב: We then proceed to Ma'ariv for Rosh Hashanah	50	23	53
ושמרו: Just before the Amidah we add the special Shabbat paragraph (V'Shomru) before reciting Tiku BaChodesh Shofar תקעו בחדש שופר	60	29	65
עמידה: Amidah - Remember to include the Shabbat additions	62-74	31-39	67-83
ויכלו: After the Amidah we may say Vayechulu, even alone. Preferably it should be said with another person, because we are bearing witness. We do not say the subsequent bracha or Magen Avoty	76	39	83
לדוד מזמור: At this point it is our custom to recite L'David Mizmor	78	91	85
